
Ah, dearest Jesus, holy Child,

November medical and dental missions serve 665 at CENEP sites

As in past years, Union Church of Manila volunteers, CENEP partners and team members, and staff of local government units in each site worked hand in hand to serve as many individuals as possible. A total of 665 patients were served at the four sites: Mandaluyong - 151 (122 medical and 29 dental); Marikina - 175 (107 medical and 68 dental); Pakil, Laguna - 146 medical; Cainta, Rizal - 193 (144 medical and 49 dental).
