School year 2024-2025 has not even reached midpoint but already our education programs are progressing wonderfully.

The excitement of CENEP children

One of the goals of the Child Education and Nutrition Enhancement Program (CENEP) is to encourage very young children to learn to relate with their fellow children and to look forward to going to school. Our CENEP sites in Mandaluyong, Marikina, and Cainta are doing just that with the many engaging activities they provide, including welcoming, attendance keeping, light meal, free play, national anthem, prayer, group exercise, singing, circle time, lesson proper, group activities, heavy meal, and pack-up time. The height and weight of the children are measured monthly to monitor their growth.

Classrooms are provided with toys and games. The play set and wooden slide donated by Cornerstone Learning and Play Center is a major enticement to children of CENEP Cainta.

CENEP teachers handle 15 to 20 children per session every school day. Managing 3½ to 4½- yearold children is a daunting task, so parents are invited to provide assistance especially during the serving of meals and cleaning up.
















The achievements of GEESE and TRACE scholars

The two sites of our Literacy and Accreditation for Continuing Education (LACE) program (San Antonio National High School, Makati City and F. LACE supports the government's Alternative Learning System (ALS) that helps learners earn their elementary or high school diploma. This allows them to move on to the next academic level and improve their chances for better employment.
