CENEP: blessed with books

The Union Church of Manila Philippines Foundation, Inc. (UCMPFI) was recently blessed with a generous donation of books from The Bookmark, Inc. The books are in support of the Foundation's Child Education and Nutrition Enhancement Program (CENEP), with three pre-school sites in Metro Manila (Mandaluyong City, Marikina City, and Cainta, Rizal).

The books for children, 3.5 to 4.5 years of age, include story books (a great help to teachers for storytelling time) and learning workbooks (for individual seatwork activities). Also donated were cookbooks that will provide the CENEP cooks with new ideas on preparing nutritious meals for the children.

Having an abundant supply of good books will help instill love of reading and boost the learning experience of the children. At the same time, the CENEP teachers will have ample materials for daily classroom activities spanning an entire school year.

CENEP children are provided not only with daily nutritious food and basic pre-school learning. The year-long program also helps them develop holistically, as their daily classroom activities include playtime and games where they learn social skills which are an important part of their growth.

The three CENEP sites, Mandaluyong, Marikina, and Cainta, organized activities on October 28, 29, and 30, respectively, to observe the annual United Nations celebration. This year's theme is "Cultivating a Culture of Peace." With parents thrilled to see their children dressed in the national costume of their country of choice, the celebrations were a sight to see -- children enjoying their colorful costumes and performing their rehearsed numbers; parents sharing their children's excitement.

UCMPFI believes that letting the CENEP children experience all the programs that formal schools hold gives them a head start when they move up to kindergarten and grade school after completing their school year with CENEP.







Volunteers orientation for Medical/Dental Mission

On October 12, 2024, UCMPFI held a volunteers orientation meeting at UCM to discuss preparations for the medical and dental missions scheduled in November 2024. Twenty-four volunteers attended, each of whom agreed to be assigned a certain task to perform and committed to be present on specific dates to make sure the missions at the three CENEP sites will be sufficiently served.

Another volunteers meeting will be held on November 9 to clarify mission procedures and arrangements and firm up volunteers' commitment to their agreed tasks.
