The Union Church of Manila Philippines Foundation, Inc. (UCMPFI) would like to express its deep gratitude to its partners, friends, donors, and volunteers for their unwavering support through the years.

The Child Education and Nutrition Enhancement Program (CENEP) is now in its 22nd year of providing free pre-school education that includes daily feeding of enrolled children belonging to marginalized families.



The Grace Enough to Ensure Secondary Education (GEESE), in partnership with the Department of Education, Makati, is now in its 21st year of supporting students through senior high.

Through the Teodoro Regala Assistance for Continuing Education (TRACE), now in its 7th year, UCMPFI has supported 14 scholars through college, six of whom have already graduated and are gainfully employed.

The Literacy and Accreditation for Continuing Education (LACE) program, now in its 12th year, has enabled learners to obtain elementary and high school equivalency enabling them to move on to the next level of education and have better employment opportunities.

UCMPFI's medical and dental outreach in the three CENEP sites, with the support of LGU health workers and regular donations from pharmaceutical companies (Pascual Laboratories, Prosel Pharma, The Cathay Drug, and Sydenham Laboratories) has, over the last 23 years, reached out to almost 16,000 patients.

All these have been made possible through the tireless and selfless participation and involvement of committed volunteers through the years.

Sincere thanks likewise to the Union Church of Manila for its staunch support of UCMPFI.
